# Uniform Guide

The École has three different types of uniform: Formal, Casual and PE, to be worn depending on the day of the week, as scheduled for each class.

To promote the ideals of diversity and create an inclusive and respectful environment, The École's student uniform policies are gender neutral. Within the Formal, Casual, and Physical Education uniform types, students can choose any item of any cut. Our approach reflects the values of our community and the current trends in education in New York and around the world.

Our uniforms are available through Untold Horizons, a retailer selected for its ability to provide quality clothing for your children that is customized for The École. Please note that this is not a dress code, but a set uniform policy, meaning that all uniform items should be purchased from Untold Horizons.

The following pages contain instructions about what should be worn for each uniform type. The **Do's** page for each uniform type shows what is required, and the **Don'ts** page shows what is not allowed. Everything that is listed on the **Do's** page is required for that uniform type unless it says 'optional' next to it.

Please note Pre-Nursery children do not need to follow this guide but are expected to wear:

- A Polo with our logo, from Untold Horizons
- Any grey bottom, not necessarily from Untold Horizons

# Special Guidelines for Pre-Nursery Children

Please note this Uniform Guide applies to children from Nursery to 8<sup>th</sup> Grade.

Pre-Nursery children do not need to follow these guidelines but are expected to wear:

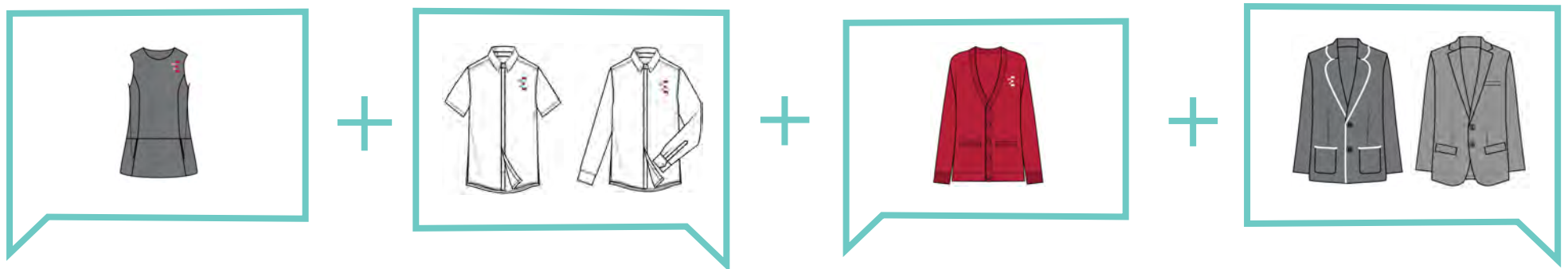
- A Polo with our logo, from Untold Horizons
- Any grey bottom, not necessarily from Untold Horizons



# Formal Uniform

The Formal uniform will be worn by all students on specific days (e.g. picture day) throughout the year. Any school-wide Formal days will be scheduled beforehand. The Formal uniform will also be worn one day a week for students in 1st through 8th Grade.

The day will be decided by each class so that it does not occur on a PE day.



# Formal Uniform

On Formal days, all students are required to wear the Formal Uniform, as described below. If a student wishes, it can be worn other days as well, but not on PE days. There are multiple bottom options, but all students must wear the white button down and blazer. The red V-neck cardigan and red sweater vest are the only sweater options for Formal days.

## Dos

- Do wear one of the four Formal bottom options:
  - Charcoal grey pants
  - Charcoal grey shorts
  - Knit neoprene jumper
  - Knit neoprene skirt
- Do wear a white button down, whether long or short-sleeved
- Do wear one of the two blazer options
- Do wear a red V-neck cardigan or sweater vest (optional)
- Do choose one of the four accessories (tie, scarf, pocket square or headband)
- Do wear black, grey or white socks or tights
- Do wear black, formal shoes

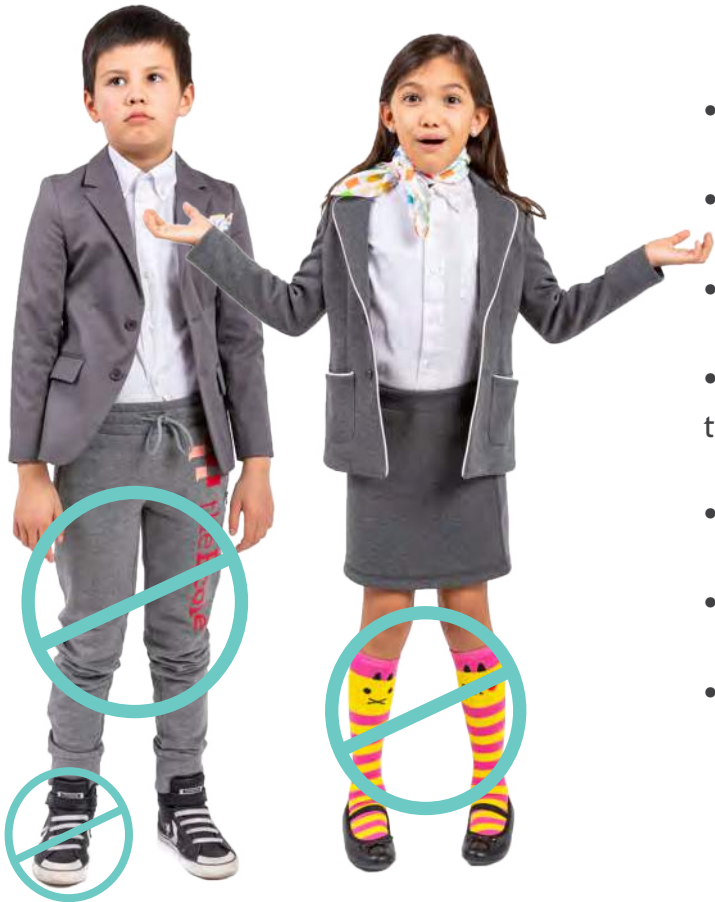


# Formal Uniform

The Formal Uniform should be the most 'uniform' of the three uniform types, with all students wearing grey bottoms, a white button down and a grey blazer. Students should not wear a polo of any color on Formal days. Students should not wear sneakers or other casual shoes on Formal days.

## Don'ts

- Don't wear jeans, sweatshorts or sweatpants
- Don't wear any shirt but a white button down
- Don't wear a vest if you're wearing the jumper
- Don't wear one of the reversible sweaters, the bomber jacket or the sweatshirt
- Don't wear sneakers or other casual shoes
- Don't wear crazy-colored socks
- Don't wear multiple accessories



# Casual Uniform

The Casual Uniform will be worn most days. There are multiple options to choose from in terms of bottoms, tops and sweaters. Students can choose from one of four colors of polos, all of which come in three styles: long-sleeved, short-sleeved or Peter Pan collar. During cooler months, students can also choose from a reversible crew neck sweater (in one of three colors), a reversible full zip (in one of three colors) or a grey knit bomber jacket.

# Casual Uniform

Casual days will be a colorful affair as students can choose from red, gold, teal or white polos and from red, gold or teal reversible sweaters, with grey on the reverse side. If wearing any non-white polo, sweaters should be worn with the grey side out.

## Dos

- Do wear one of the five Casual bottom options:
  - Dark blue jeans
  - Charcoal grey pants
  - Charcoal grey shorts
  - Knit neoprene jumper
  - Knit neoprene skirt
- Do wear one of the polo options, all of which come in red, gold, teal and white:
  - long-sleeved
  - short-sleeved
  - Peter Pan collar (in short- or long-sleeved)
- Do wear one of the sweater options (optional)
  - Reversible crew neck sweater
  - Reversible zip front sweater
  - Grey knit neoprene bomber jacket
- Do wear the reversible sweaters grey side out if wearing a polo that is NOT white
- Do wear any formal or casual, non-brightly colored shoes
- Do wear black, grey or white socks or tights





# Casual Uniform

Although Casual days will be colorful, we don't want colors to be clashing. If wearing a colored polo and one of the reversible sweaters, the sweater should be worn grey side out. Reversible sweaters should only be worn with the red, gold or teal side out if wearing a white polo.

## Don'ts

- Don't wear sweatshorts or sweatpants
- Don't wear any EINY shirts, sweatshirts or cardigans
- Don't wear the PE sweatshirt, red V-neck cardigan or red sweater vest
- Don't wear one of the reversible sweaters with the non-grey side out if wearing a polo that is not white
- Don't wear light-up or fluorescent sneakers, flip flops or similar footwear
- Don't wear crazy-colored socks
- Don't wear The École tie with any polo



# Physical Education Uniform

The PE Uniform should only be worn on gym/sport days. Sweatpants, sweatshorts and sweatshirts are all made of sturdy fleece, and the polos are the same as for the Casual Uniform.

# Physical Education Uniform

## Dos

- Do wear one of the two PE bottom options: sweatpants or sweatshorts
- Do wear one of the polo options, all of which come in red, gold, teal and white:
  - long-sleeved
  - short-sleeved
  - Peter Pan collar (in short- or long-sleeved)
- Do wear the PE sweatshirt (optional)
- Do wear sneakers
- Do wear black, grey or white socks



# Physical Education Uniform

## Don'ts

- Don't wear leggings, jeans or any bottoms other than The École sweatshorts or sweatpants
- Don't wear any EINY shirts, sweatshirts or cardigans
- Don't wear any of the reversible sweaters, the bomber jacket, the cardigan or vest
- Don't wear any shoes other than sneakers (no formal shoes, Uggs, flip flops)
- Don't wear light-up or fluorescent sneakers
- Don't wear any accessories other than The École headband, which is optional
