Welcome to our October Camp!

Join us for an enriching, immersive—and fun—bilingual experience!

From Monday, October 10 to Friday, October 14. we welcome all children aged 3 to 10 years old—both students of The École and neighborhood friends. There is no minimum level of French or English required to take part!

At our Flatiron District campus and the surrounding Madison Square Park and Peter's Field, campers learn and practice both French and English through daily fine art, music, theater, sport, dance and many other STEM activities!

For children from Nursery to Kindergarten, The École October Camp takes place in our Maternelle Building, and in our Elementary and Middle School Building for 1st to 5th Grade students.

Throughout the day, children are guided through workshops and activities by a camp team composed entirely of The École's school life assistants, staff, teachers, and instructors from our After-School program partners. All are native speakers of French or English and all are deeply experienced in working with language learners of all levels. They ensure campers have the opportunity to improve their French and English language skills, at their own pace and in relaxed, enriching settings.

Pick-Up

Please consult this brochure for start and finish times and make sure to be on time to pick-up your children.

- Lateness Fee for After-School Pick-Up: children must be picked up promptly at the end time specified for their camp. Due to the need to compensate staff who wait with children who are picked up late, there will be a charge for late pickup to the amount of \$20 per every full or partial quarter of an hour late.
- Pick-Up Points:
 - Maternelle Building: on the $\mathbf{5}^{\mathrm{th}}$ floor.
 - Elementary & Middle School Building: in the lobby.

- The school provides a snack in the morning and in the afternoon. Parents may also provide their own if they prefer.

Nursery to Kindergarten camp is held at the Maternelle Building 206 Fifth Avenue, New York, NY 10010

The days begin at 8:30 a.m. with a morning welcome followed by the first activity, an outdoor recess (at Madison Square Park or on our rooftop, weather permitting) followed by a second activity.

Then it's time for lunch and quiet games, and, for our youngest campers, nap time.

The three afternoon workshop activities, just like those held in the morning, are run in French or English. A snack is provided in the afternoon.

Parents can pick their children up between 4:45 p.m. and 5 p.m.

Please note that lunch will not be provided by the camp.

Descriptions of the Activities

Arts avec Adeline Berlioz, en français

Adeline will take the children on an artistic journey, crossing eras and spaces. Together, they will discover new cultures and create an artistic project to take home. Through their travels, they will also learn different types of artistic techniques.

Body Movement with Emilie Aguerre, in English

Jump, spin, and slide into this amazing dance workshop! In this perfect introduction to dance, we will explore creative movement, ballet, and Broadway musical theater. The children will learn the art of story-telling through music and movement with classical music and fun filled songs. They will also learn skills like listening and how to follow instructions, working alongside their peers, taking turns, setting goals and feeling the excitement of achieving them!

Drone Pilots Course

During this workshop, Aurélien will introduce children to theater through body and speech. Children will work on appropriation of space, of oneself, of others, and the interactions.
